Who are EirGrid?

EirGrid operate and develop the national high voltage electricity grid in Ireland. (Read more here)

What is the difference between EirGrid and ESB?

➤ EirGrid is independent from ESB. EirGrid operate the flow of power on the grid and plan for its future, while ESB Networks is responsible for carrying out maintenance, repairs, and construction on the grid. The grid moves wholesale power around the country by bringing energy from generation stations to heavy industry and high-tech users. (Read more here)

When do applications close?
