

EirGrid is the national state-owned company that manages and operates the electricity transmission grid across the island of Ireland. EirGrid has recently completed an infrastructure project in Kilmorna comprising a new substation and associated 2.8km of new overhead line.

EirGrid is establishing a community fund for the benefit of communities close to project to the value of €70,500. The two villages of Knockanure and Duagh are incorporated within the geographic region of the fund and all PPN registered local community and volunteer organisations are encouraged to apply.

EirGrid is calling for projects that focus on one of two broad themes:

- Provision or enhancement of community infrastructure and amenities;
- Provision of community educational initiatives;

The minimum and maximum value per application is between €500 & €25,000.

The fund will be administered in partnership with Kerry County Council. All applications will be reviewed by the EirGrid Knockanure Duagh Community Fund Evaluation Committee which will consist of EirGrid and Kerry County Council staff members.
