





# **Project Update**

#### **Cable Works**

- First of HVAC cables delivered ahead of the start of cable laying activities this summer.
- 45% of the trenching and ducting works are completed on the HV AC section Knockraha to Ballyadam.
- Section B is due to complete reinstatement this week.
- Section E trenching and ducting is progressing on schedule.
- Section C trenching and ducting commencing 07 March.
- Section F due to commence, on completion of Section E.

### **Claycastle Landfall**

• Test archaeological dig is to take place in March ahead of any wider archaeological dig in Autumn.


#### Marine Surveys

- Site access.






# **Project progress and actions**


# **Road Closure Sections**

### Funding streams: Community, Sustainability and Biodiversity


Fund strategy: Resulting from collaborative consultation process led out by SECAD and supported by EirGrid

# Community Benefit Fund Process






# Fund Application Overview SECAD
