## DSU Derogation Application Guideline for Submission of DSU Derogation Application

Below is a guideline for the submission of a new derogation application for a DSU and the submission of an update to an existing derogation application for a DSU whereby changes have occurred to the overall number of sites and/or Demand Side Unit MW Capacity.

## **A New Derogation Application**

Applicant: Please provide the company name and contact details of the relevant person.

<u>Grid Code Clause/Version:</u> Please specify the Section/Clause/Definition from which the derogation is sought and the relevant Grid Code Version.

<u>Plant/System for which Derogation is Sought</u>: Please provide the assigned three letter code and include the total number of Individual Demand Sites (IDSs) and the Demand Side Unit MW Capacity as specified in the Operational Certificate.

Please attach to the Derogation Application the list of MPRNs for the unit and specify which of these the Derogation Application applies to.

Once the Derogation Application has been received it will be validated by the TSO within 10 working days and a DAID number will be assigned, assuming all information is provided in the application the Application enters the derogation assessment process.

## An Update to an Existing Derogation Application Currently under TSO Assessment

Please update the existing Derogation Application should the status/description of the DSU change e.g. IDSs are added to or removed from a DSU or the DSU MW Capacity changes.

If the new IDSs are compliant with Grid Code, and do not relate to the derogation(s) sought, it will be necessary to update the application to reflect the Demand Side Unit MW Capacity and number of sites in the revised Operational Certificate.

## An Update to a Derogation Application that has been ruled upon by the CER

A new Derogation Application is required.
