

Open Call – Closed 30th September 2021

- Rural businesses seeking to reach new markets, expand, innovate and/or diversify in response to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and/or Brexit.
- Community based projects that seek to address the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic (e.g. accessibility/wellbeing/outdoor recreation)
- Applicants that have not previously received assistance under LEADER
- New & innovative projects climate change, environmental protection and the green economy
- Maximising the potential of broadband & the digital economy (remote working facilities / rural hubs)




