3. Coolnabacky Substation Planning Update

Des Cox (EirGrid) outlined the Proposed Modification to ABP approved Development of Coollnabacky Substation

- ESB Networks has undertaken detailed design of the Coolnabacky substation previously approved by ABP
- The process has identified the need for minor modifications to the previously approved Substation Design and Layout.
 - 400kV Substation Building Repositioned 2 Metres north
 - 400kV Gantry Slightly shifted southwest
 - 2 Transformer Bunds to replace original consented bund
 - Substation Compound Internal Layout Minor Reconfiguration
 - Substation Compound Access Track Slight Reconfiguration
 - Substation Drainage Network Minor adjustment to surface water collection network.

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Section 146B – Modification of SID Approvals

- Section 146B of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) allows for requests to ABP to modify previously approved Strategic Infrastructure Development (SID)
- The S146B process involves submissions directly to ABP without prior public notice
- If ABP deems the request 'not material' it will decide the modifications without public input.
- If ABP deems the request 'material' it will instruct EirGrid to publish notices inviting public submissions to ABP ahead of it deciding on the modifications

• There are no statutory timelines for the S146B process

Phase 1: (40%) €204,600 – Starting Construction (Funding Already Allocated – April 2022)

Phase 2: 30% (€153,450) - Line Stringing/Cable Jointing (– process ongoing, project proposals are with EirGrid for approval)

Phase 3 30% (€153,450) Energisation (Will be opened in line with project progress.)

Laois Kilkenny Community Benefit Fund Phase 2

Fund Value - €153,450 Opening Date - 23rd April 2024 Closing Date - 18th June 2024

Fund Principles

- Must support projects that are community led and not-for-profit
- Will leave a positive legacy within communities that host the Laois Kilkenny Reinforcement Infrastructure
- Will support Projects which align to the Sustainable Development Goals
- Will be delivered in a fair and balanced way

Fund Application Overview

- 15 Applications received
- 1 Application deemed ineligible
- A total of €253,251.53 funding requested representing 165% of the fund value
- All applications received were located within the Area of Benefit (i.e. 3km from the reinforcement line)

EirGrid hope to be in a position to announce the outcome of the funding in the near future and M-CO and Avril Wilson (EirGrid) will be in touch with all applicants. Sincere thanks to all community forum members for their work to date on this fund. Announcing the results of the Phase 2 call is a huge milestone for the project.
