Modification Description Overview: The Reason for the Recommended Modification	Grid Code Modification Proposal MPID 223 was approved by CER on 28 th September 2015. MPID 223 changed the time allowed for a Generation Unit to synchronise, from 5 minutes, to 15 minutes, after the Synchronising time. However the definition Failure to Follow Notice to Synchronise was not updated to reflect this change. The purpose of this modification (MPID 267) is to align the definition Failure to Follow Notice to Synchronise with the approved MPID 223.
History of Progression through GCRPs, Working Group and/or Consultation	MPID 267 was proposed and agreed at the GCRP meeting #04/2015 that took place in Belfast on 2 December 2016.
