Modification Proposal Justification:

The definition of "Generator Declared Inflexibilities" is no longer aligned with the current Grid Code framework. The term appears only in the glossary and is not referenced in any operative provisions.

The original definition refers to a clause that no longer exists in the current Code structure, and the associated obligations have since been incorporated into broader provisions within SDC1 without reliance on this term.

As such, the definition is redundant and its continued inclusion introduces potential ambiguity without providing functional value.

It is proposed to remove the definition, subject to confirmation that it is not required by external frameworks. This is a clarificatory change and has no impact on existing operational or market processes.
