


Activation Energy

- Electricity Supply License from CER

Our observations


Control is easy and cheap

Monitoring is expensive and hard

Not practical for smaller pieces of equipment



Proposal



ACTIVATION ENERGY

Proposal

 Deploy monitoring equipment on a statistically representative sample of an equipment type
(Pop - 50,000-100,000, +/-10, 95%, sample of 96)

Make this data available to EirGrid as a proxy for all other similar equipment

No need to install further monitoring equipment



Outcome

- Large quantities of new Capacity for the System
 - Comfort Cooling 83MW*

Diverse sources

 Equipment which could be cycled easily and regularly (Facilitate Ramping?)
