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1 Introduction

1.1 Background and Purpose

In accordance with provisions set forth in the Terms and Conditions for the fourth onshore Competition under the Renewable Electricity Support Scheme published in May 2024 and pursuant to Public Service Obligations imposed under Section 39 of the Act, the Auction administrator is responsible for administering RESS 4. The following sections describe the:

- Qualification process steps for sections 8.2 and 8.3 of the Terms and Conditions, and
- The Roles and Responsibilities and obligations of each entity.

In accordance with section 6 of the RESS 4 terms and conditions, all Applicants must provide evidence to the Auction Administrator with the Application for Qualification that the eligibility requirements set out in Section 6 have been met. The Auction Administrator must be satisfied that all eligibility criteria set out in the RESS 4 Terms and Conditions have been met for that particular RESS 4 Applicant to participate in the RESS 4 Auction. The RESS 4 Qualification process consists of the following high level steps:



Qualification Submission

Qualification Assessment

 The Auction Administrator evaluates the RESS 4 Application submissions and determines if a project is eligible to progress to the RESS 4 Auction stage.



Oualification Results

 The RESS 4 Qualification results are compiled and submitted to the Minister for a final review and decision.




The following process flow diagrams are made up of columns that identify who are responsible for what activities. Typical roles include the:

- DECC




Example of Roles and Responsibilities swim lanes
